

## Directions



Pop IP12 1AA into your sat-nav and this route will bring you into the town centre where you can park in one of the main shopping car parks (New Street). You can exit the car park on foot by various walkways but they will take you either out on to the Thoroughfare or connect you to the bottom of New Street, where a short walk up the hill brings you to the Market Hill. You can also park in Hamblin Road (IP12 1AA) and Deben Road (IP12 1AZ) which are also town centre locations. Follow the brown roadside signs for particular areas of interest. Once you get here, just ask someone to help – we're generally a friendly bunch.

On Foot

Woodbridge is along a distance footpath known as The Sandlings Walk (55 miles, 89 Km) that runs to Southwold through the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty- Suffolk Coast & Heaths. Woodbridge offers superb accommodation for walkers following this route.
